INSTRUCTIONS FOR ADMISSION – 2018 – 19
ISC (Class XI)


1. Application Forms for ISC (Class XI) 2018 – 19 may be accessed on the school website, www.clarencehighschool.in from April 09, 2018 onwards. The online submission of the form includes the online payment of a registration fee of Rs 500/- per applicant.
2. The e-brochure is available for download free of charge. Please go through the brochure carefully before attempting registration.
3. Filling up of wrong information online or failure to submit relevant documents to corroborate the information will result in the applicant not being considered for admission. Incomplete forms will be summarily rejected.
4. Generally a small percent of applicants secure admission here. It would be helpful to apply in other schools also.
5. Please note that ISC syllabus is followed in Clarence, not PUC or CBSE.
6. Clarence Education Trust follows a NO CAPITATION FEE POLICY for admissions. The Board of Management & Principal of Clarence High School wish to inform the general public that no person in or outside Clarence high school is authorised to take donations on behalf of the school with regard to admissions. We do not have or entertain any agent or middleman. Unscrupulous persons may try to hoodwink parents posing as influencers and cheat public. Please do not succumb to such tricks. Any admissions obtained through such means will immediately be cancelled and legal action taken against such persons if found guilty. Eligibility Criteria:

7. Pass Certificate in Class X from ICSE Board with an average 85% marks for Science Stream, and 80% marks for Commerce and humanities Stream. Further details are available with the application form.
8. The school does not accept donations either directly or indirectly.
9. Recommendation letters will not be entertained.
10. Kindly refrain from making enquiries over the telephone as the school may not be able to answer all calls in this regard. Email would be preferred. Please write to principal@clarencehighschool.in

Admission Process:

11. Admission will be given on the spot to candidates who meet the eligibility criteria by walk-in interview which will commence two days after the declaration of ICSE results.
12. Candidates who are given admission should complete the admission formalities including payment of fees on the same day itself.
13. Information about fee structure, documents needed at the time of registration, and those to be carried along for walk-in interview is available in the brochure.
14. Meeting with candidates who have dropped their application form in the DROP BOX ,and their parents, will be intimated through SMS, depending on the availability of seats after on-the spot admissions are over.
15. Classes will start in the third week of June. The exact dates will be intimated at the time of admission.
