3. Criteria for the candidate to be called for Provisional Admission in **May 2021**:
 - a. Science Stream: Scores in the Model Examination (Offline) in English, Science, Math and best one other Subject (not including Scripture/Moral Science)
 - b. Commerce Stream: Scores in the Model Examination (Offline) in English, Math, Group III Elective and best one subject (not including Scripture/Moral Science)
 - c. Humanities Stream: Scores in English, HCG, and best two subjects (not including Scripture/Moral Science) in the Model Examination (Offline).
4. Fees:
 - a. Admission Fees: Rs. 36,500/- (one time)
 - b. Annual Tuition Fees: Rs. 72,000/- (payable in full)
5. Application forms will be available online from **March 15, 2021**. Hard copies of the application are no longer provided. The application should be filled up online and submitted online. When you submit the form online, a registration fee of Rs. 500/- will also have to be paid online as processing charges. The soft copy of the submitted online application will automatically be sent to your email address (please check your junk folder also).

6. A printout of the completed Application form should be taken, by clicking on the Link and fee paid receipt that will be received in your registered email. The printed application form along with the following documents should be submitted at the front gate. The security officer will issue an acknowledgement for the application submitted.
7. Based on the marks in the Model Examination, candidates will be called for interview and provisional admission will take place on **May 10 & 11, 2021**. The candidate should come with both parents and all original documents. If selected, the payment of Admission Fees and Full Tuition Fees for Class 11 should take place within 2 days.
8. Refund of Fees:
 - a. If the candidate was not able to pass the ICSE Board examination, the admission will be cancelled and 90% of the admission Fee will be refunded.
 - b. If the candidate chooses to withdraw from the program for any other reason,
 - i. before May 15, 2021, 50% of the Admission Fee will be refunded and 100% of Tuition Fees.
 - ii. From May 16, 2021 to June 1, 2021, None of Admission Fee and 100% of Tuition Fees
 - iii. From June 1, 2021 to June 15, 2021, 50% of Tuition Fees
 - iv. After June 16, 2021, no refund.
9. Attested copies of the following documents should accompany the printed application form (in the following order mandatorily)
 - a. Passport size Photos of the Applicant and both parents (taken professionally in a studio)
 - b. Address Proof
 - c. Birth Certificate
 - d. Attested Photocopy of Std. 10 Model Examination (Offline) Marks Statement
 - e. Copy of Passport with Visa (only for those students who hold foreign citizenship)
 - f. Annual Income proof of both parents
10. **Confirmation of Admission:** This will take place 2 days after the ICSE results are declared. The Confirmed admission letter will be issued at this time.
11. The following original documents should be submitted at the time of confirmation of admission:
 - a. Self-Attested Internet Statement of Marks from digilocker for Class 10 [ICSE Examination 2021] with the statement, “Downloaded from _____ (name of website) on _____(date).”
 - b. Official Transfer Certificate (ORIGINAL)
 - c. Conduct Certificate (ORIGINAL)
12. At least one parent must accompany the candidate for the interview.

 - a. The School does not accept any donations either directly or indirectly.
 - b. Recommendation letters will NOT be entertained.
